


All Just Glass


Poison Tree

Alysia tells herself that she has put her days as a mercenary for the brutal Burja Guilds behind her. She has been on the run for two years, with a two million dollar price on her head, but her past keeps interfering with her attempts to start a new life. A human among throngs of vampires, witches, shapeshifters, and Tristes, Alysia has always been determined to prove herself more than a mere mortal. Will becoming a member of SingleEarth allow her to finally put her past behind her? On a stormy night, three bolts are shot by someone who knows their way around a crossbow. But when they discover a wounded half-man—a bioengineered war beast named Tool—who is being hunted by a vengeful band of soldiers, their fragile existence quickly collapses. One is taken prisoner by merciless soldier boys, and the other is faced with an impossible decision: Risk everything to save a friend, or flee to a place where freedom might finally be possible. Every Other Day

Every other day, Kali D'Angelo is a normal sixteen-year-old girl. She goes to public high school. She attends pep rallies. She's human. Then every day in between, she is something else entirely. Though she still looks like herself, every twenty-four hours predatory instincts take over and Kali becomes a feared demon-hunter with the undeniable urge to hunt, trap, and kill zombies, hellhounds, and other supernatural creatures. On those days, she is practically indestructible. Kali has no idea why she is the way she is, but she gives in to instinct anyway. When Kali notices a mark on a popular girl at school, she knows instantly that the girl is marked for death by an unworldly being. She knows that she has only twenty-four hours to save her. There is one problem, it is the wrong twenty-four hours. Recommendation: 📖📖📖.




Black Heart

crimes if he will only leave his con artist family behind and go straight. But why does going straight feel so crooked.? Recommendation: 📖.




Halflings

A growing attraction between Nikki and two of her protectors presents a whole other danger. While she risks a broken heart, Mace and Raven could lose everything, including their souls. As the mysteries behind the boys' powers, as well as her role in a scientist's dark plan, unfold, Nikki is faced with choices that will affect the future of an entire race of heavenly beings, as well as the precarious equilibrium of the earthly world. She soon learns that while she might be safe from the wrath of the Furies of the Underworld, the people she loves on earth are not. Can she convince him to release her in order to save the life of someone in her? Will the price he asks her to pay for her freedom turn out to be too high? Recommendation: 📖. 


Thirteen Days to Midnight


Out of Sight, Out of Time (Gallagher Series #5)

For a while, it seems like Mickey's train-wreck of a life is finally improving - until Ashley vanishes without a trace. Unwilling to let another person walk out of his life, Mickey follows Ashley's trail into a seedy underworld that reveals that this seemingly sweet, shy girl isn't who she claimed to be. And neither was Mickey's father. Soon, Mickey learns about a conspiracy so shocking that it makes high school drama seem like a luxury and leaves him questioning everything about the life he thought he knew. **Recommendation:** 📖.

Let us rejoice and be glad in it.*" A block from Miss Veola and up a hill in Chalk, Train Greene, thin and hungry, burns with anger. He has a decision to make, and he's running out of time. A few miles away, among finer houses, Kelvin Hartley yawns and gets ready for another day at school, where he is a friend to all and makes an effort at nothing. And Doria Bell, who recently moved to the South from Connecticut, walks to the bus stop, hoping the high school kids who live nearby will say hello.




Jason Steed – Fledgling




Rift (Prequel to Nightshade Series)



Set in 1897 England, sixteen year-old Finley Jayne has no one except the “thing” insider her. When a young lord tries to take advantage of Finley, she fights back and wins. But no normal Victorian girl has a darker side that makes her capable of knocking out a full-grown man with one punch. Only Griffin King sees the magical darkness inside her that says she's special, says she's one of them. The orphaned duke takes her in from the gas lit streets against the wishes of his band of misfits: Emily, who has her own special abilities and an unrequited love for Sam, who is part robot; and Jasper, an American cowboy with a shadowy secret.

Griffin's investigating a criminal called The Machinist, the mastermind behind several recent crimes by automatons. Finley thinks she can help and finally be a part of something, finally fit in. But The Machinist wants to tear Griff's little company of strays apart, and it isn't long before trust is tested on all sides. At least Finley knows whose side she's on—even if it seems no one believes her. Recommendation: 📖.

Worse yet, it's mutating, and all evidence suggests that it will bring humanity to its knees. Mark and Trina are convinced there's a way to save those left living from descending into madness. 


***A Gift of Magic*


Silence (Older Teens)


If I Stay (Older Teens)






The Fear






The Name of the Star (Older Teens)




Dead Beautiful
