Retail salespersons, cashiers, fast food workers, waiters, office clerks, cooks, nurses aides, custodians, pharmacy technicians, and receptionists clerks

*per year per household*

**50% to 80% Median Family Income**

Elementary school teachers, electricians, carpenters, bookkeeping, dental & medical assistants, correctional officers, firefighters, plumbers
