Princess Place, Russell Landing closed due to flooding

November 27, 2017 – Princess Place Preserve and the Haw Creek Preserve (Russell Landing) are closed until further notice because of localized flooding.

“It is not safe for the public to travel on the roads through Princess Place,” said General Services Director Heidi Petito. “The hardwood swamp that borders Haw Creek is flooded.

Both parks will remain closed until the water has a chance to recede and the shell roadways have dried out enough to be safe for parking.

The closures include trails, camping and the canoe/kayak launch areas.

The Haw Creek Preserve is located at 2007 County Road 2007 in western Flagler County. Princess Place Preserve is located at 2500 Princess Place Road.

Signs and barricades are in place. County Road 2007 on Monday was closed between the Pellicer Community Center and Russell Landing.

“Once the flooding has subsided, staff will be working diligently to reopen the park,” said County Administrator Craig Coffey.
