Apply for Rebuild Florida repair money in Flagler Beach

September 28, 2018 – The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity is staging a mobile intake bus in Flagler Beach to help residents apply for a portion of the \$616 million allocated through “Rebuild Florida” to repair homes significantly damaged by Hurricane Irma.

The bus is expected to be at the Flagler Beach Library, 315 S. 7th Street, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily starting Monday, October 1, through Saturday, October 6.

“Certain communities are prioritized, but we are encouraging residents throughout Flagler County to apply for assistance,” said Flagler County Emergency Management Chief Jonathan Lord.

Rebuild Florida’s Housing Repair and Replacement Program will manage and complete the construction process of damaged homes on behalf of low-income homeowners. Projects for consideration include:

- Repairs to, reconstruction, or replacement of homes – including work that brings the home into code compliance and provides resiliency for future storms.
- Completion of work to homes that have been partially repaired.
- Repair or replacement of manufactured and mobile homes.

Eligible Florida residents have until Dec. 23 to register for the Rebuild Florida Housing Repair and Replacement Program.
