Dear Mr. Dickson:

A complaint telephone call was received on February 23, 2018, concerning asbestos in the former Memorial Hospital Building at 901 East Moody Boulevard, in Bunnell, Florida. During the complaint investigation, possible violations of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M, asbestos NESHAP, were observed.

61.145(b)(1) of the asbestos NESHAP states:

(b) Notification requirements. Each owner or operator of a demolition or renovation activity to which this section applies shall:

(1) Provide the Administrator with written notice of intention to demolish or renovate.

The Department does not have record of the required written notification for the demolition of the former Memorial Hospital Building that occurred in March 2017.


Violations of Florida Statutes or administrative rules may result in liability for damages and restoration, and the judicial imposition of civil penalties, pursuant to Sections 403.061, Florida Statutes.

The Department is interested in receiving any facts you may have that will assist in determining whether any violations have occurred. You may bring anyone with you to the meeting that you feel could help resolve this matter.

We look forward to your cooperation in completing the investigation and resolving this matter as soon as possible.
