2. Minutes from March 21st were approved as written.
3. PAL –
 - a. Kim Hale updated the committee on all the activities and where they are in the planning process. She indicated the need for three more groups to man tables for the walk through time. He interviewed residents of Flagler County and took images of several historic sites. Mr. Brotemarkle agreed so Carl contacted the Flagler Auditorium for the screening. It will be free to the public.
