As part of our centennial celebration we will hide 11 caches and 1 bonus cache. These caches will be located in places with historical significance to Flagler County. Using the GPS coordinates provided you will then be able to locate the caches. Each cache will contain a log book to sign in, a pencil, and a QR code.

On April 29, 2017 you will be given a brochure with all the information you need to find the caches. Using the QR code provided scan the code to reveal a special word. Write the word in the coordinating spot inside the brochure for proof that you found the cache.

The first 100 people to find the 11 caches will receive a commemorative geocoin. The first person to find all 11 and the bonus cache will receive a \$100 "cache" prize.
