## Story Events

**Baby Class** is an interactive event for children from **birth to two years** with an adult caregiver. The class includes rhymes, songs, fingerplays, movement activities and books to promote language development and positive interactions between parent and child.

**Children's Story Class** is for children **two years through age six years (those who are able to sit for a story)** with an adult caregiver. The event includes books, songs, rhymes, movement activities and crafts as well as occasional puppet shows and special guests. Children's Story Class reinforces literacy skills and a lifelong love of books and reading.

## Other Events

**American Girl** is open to children **ages 6 years and older** and is based on the American Girl series of books. Participants learn about the book characters and their times through activities such as reader's theater, games and crafts.

**Book Clubs** are **afterschool** clubs for **ages 8 – 11 years** with a maximum of twelve participants in each of the two chapters (one for girls/one for boys). **Pre-registration is required.** Members read the same title and meet once a month for a discussion and book related activities and snacks.

**Family Movie Night** – Join us for family friendly recently released films as well as classics and old favorites. **All ages.**

**Game Day** is for Yu-Gi-Oh card trading & swapping, & friendly competition, as well as other board and card games to play with old and new friends. **Ages 6 years and older.**

**LEGO** – This is a “hands on” event that provides an opportunity to make new friends and for families to work creatively together. Building with interlocking blocks is imaginative, challenging, mechanical and fun! **All ages.**

**PAWS to Read** is for children of **ages 3 and up** who like books and dogs. Children are given the opportunity to practice reading skills while sharing a story with a real dog and its handler. All canine participants are certified Ambassador Dogs. One-on-one sessions in a non-threatening environment help to build confidence and make reading fun.

**Kids in Motion** = music + movement + props = Fitness Fun. Build motor and listening skills while having fun. This event is for children of **all ages.**

**Saturday Crafts** is a family workshop which includes a variety of make and take crafts. **All ages.**

**Science Matters** is a program for ages **6 – 12 years** with a **maximum of 30 participants. Preregistration begins 30 minutes prior to program beginning in the Children's Department.** Participants explore the why's and how's of scientific principles found in some of our favorite stories. The program includes a story and plenty of hands on experiences.
