Senior Energy Program Hits Cooling Season

Flagler County Senior Services has geared up for the summer heat with availability of energy assistance. The cooling season runs from April 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018. The Emergency Home Energy Assistance Program (EHEAP) is a program that assists low-income households experiencing a home energy emergency provided the household includes **at least one person age 60 or older**, residing in **Flagler County**, meets **qualifying factors** to include **gross income** and **family size** and **presents all required documentation**. The program is administered through a contractual relationship between the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) and the Department of Elder Affairs. The Flagler County Board of County Commissioners, Senior Services Division, is the provider for Flagler County by way of an agreement with the Northeast Florida Area Agency on Aging, Inc., d/b/a Eldersource, Jacksonville, Florida.

Eligible households may receive one benefit during this cooling season for a maximum of \$600. A cooling crisis is described as: the household's home **cooling energy sources has been cut off**; the household has been notified that the **energy source is going to be cut off**; the household has received notice indicating the energy source is **delinquent or past due**; or, the household has **other problems with lack of cooling in the home**.
