• ENERGY ASSISTANCE – BY APPOINTMENT

Emergency Home Energy Assistance Program (EHEAP) is offered to low-income Flagler households with a senior, **60 years of age and older** residing. Crisis includes: Pending or actual shut-off; notice of delinquent or past due; the household has other problems with lack of energy in the home. This does **NOT** include water bills.
